Universal Remote Control Owner's Manual

SAVE THIS MANUAL AND THE CODE LISTS!

Remote controls can sometimes lose their programming when you change the batteries. Make sure you keep the manual and code lists in a safe place so that you can reprogram the remote if you need to.

Tip: This remote is already programmed to operate most Samsung TVs and Comcast cable boxes. Just press the corresponding key—TV for a television, or SAT•CBL•STREAM for a cable box. To program for other brands or devices, follow the directions in the Programming the Remote section.

Battery Installation

Your RCRH02BE universal remote requires 2 new AAA alkaline batteries (sold separately).

To install the batteries:

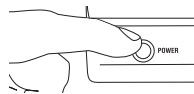
1. Turn the unit over, remove screw and remove the battery door compartment cover.
2. Insert the batteries, matching the batteries to the (+) and (-) marks inside the battery case.

Battery Precautions:

- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Always remove old, weak or worn-out batteries promptly and recycle or dispose of them in accordance with Local and National Regulations.

Programming the Remote

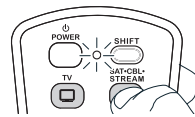
To use this universal remote with your home entertainment system, first you need to program it to control your devices. Direct Code Entry lets you enter a code from the accompanying code list for your brand of device.



1. Manually turn on the device you want to control.



2. Find the Code List that came with the remote. Locate the section for the type of device you're trying to program, and find your brand in that section. Circle the codes for your brand and keep them handy.



3. Press and hold the device key you want to program for about 2 seconds, until the indicator light illuminates and stays on. Then release the key.



4. Enter the first five-digit code for your brand in the code list (the indicator light flashes after each digit).

5. When you've finished entering the five-digit code, look at the indicator light.

Did the indicator light turn off?

YES: You're done! You've programmed this device key.

NO, it's still illuminated: You have either entered a code number that is not in the code lists or missed a step in the code entry procedure. Try step 4 again.

NOTES

Test the remote with the device to make sure the device key is programmed with the correct code for maximum functionality. If some features don't work, try a different code in the list.

Using Arrow and OK Keys (SHIFT mode)

The CH and VOL keys can be used as arrow keys in the menu or guide systems of your devices. In addition, the ENTER key can be used as an OK key. This functionality is accessed with the SHIFT key.

To access SHIFT mode (CH / VOL become arrow keys and ENTER becomes OK): Press the SHIFT key. The remote's indicator light flashes. The VOL and CH keys function as left/right and up/down arrows and the ENTER key works as OK.

To return to regular key functionality: Press the SHIFT key again. The CH and VOL keys go back to being channel and volume keys and the ENTER key enters channel numbers. The remote also automatically returns to normal key functionality after 20 seconds without a keypress.

Accessing HOME screens for Streaming Players

The  key controls Samsung Hub functionality on TVs. It may also control similar functionality on other devices (see your device manual for information) **including access to HOME screens for streaming players.**

Accessing Digital Channels

The INPUT and — (dash) key lets you enter a digital sub-channel number, like 59.1, directly. Use the number keys to enter the main channel number (in this case, "59"). Then press the INPUT (-) key and press the subchannel number (in this case, "1").

Care and Maintenance

- Keep the remote dry. If it gets wet, wipe it dry immediately.
- Use and store the remote only in normal temperature environments.
- Handle the remote gently and carefully. Don't drop it.
- Keep the remote away from dust and dirt.
- Wipe the remote with a damp cloth occasionally to keep it looking new.
- Modifying or tampering with the remote's internal components can cause malfunction and invalidate its warranty.
